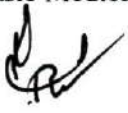

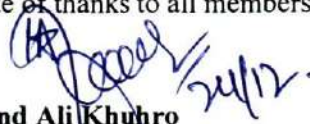
**SUBJECT: MINUTES OF FINANCIAL BID OPENING MEETING**
