The original income certificate issued by Deputy Commissioner / Mukhtiarkar (Revenue) 2025 of the concerned District must be enclosed with the application. (Not accepted 2024 Income certificate)


This may also be noted that incomplete applications forms and those received after due date will not be forwarded.

The students who are already in receipt of any scholarship for financial assistance from government should not apply. The application form is available at the Photostat shop in University (Main Campus & New Campus).

3. Student informed that their Father/ Guardian is working Private Job / Land Lard (submit original Income Certificate) issued by Assistant Commissioner / Mukhtiarkar (Revenue) of the concerned district (Not allowed the photocopy)
